☐ Establish a Buddy System If you are not at home plan with neighbors to find care for your pets. Do the same for them when they are gone.
☐ Gather Important Information Gather together all important documents and proof of ownership in an easily accessible place.
☐ Take Photos of You With Your Pet Photos can be used to help identify your pet or to verify ownership.
☐ Have an Emergency Kit It is important to have a kit of needed supplies.
☐ List Community Resources for Pets Know who and where to turn to before a disaster strikes.
