## Martingale Dog Leash

We use these leashes for dogs in the shelter. The size below works for medium to large dogs. You can take a couple inches off the collar to make a small dog version.

## Supplies

- 18 " of $11 / 2$ "or 2 " width strapping for collar
- $21 / 2$ yards of 1 " width strapping for lead
- 2 ‘D’ rings
- 1 plastic grommet or bead with $3 / 4$ " opening
- Remnant of stretch fleece
- Stuffing for cushioning inside collar and lead handle loop


## Directions

- Thread collar strapping through D ring
- Fold over 2"
- Reinforce stitch $\qquad$
- Repeat on opposite end of collar
- Line inside of collar with fleece and cushioning
- Thread lead strapping through D rings
- Fold over 14 " to form 27 " adjustable loop section
- Slip grommet onto loop section
- Reinforce stitch 2" $\qquad$
- Fold over $81 / 2$ " to create 16 " lead handle loop
- Reinforce stitch 2" $\square$
- Line inside lead handle loop with fleece and cushioning
