**MINUTES OF THE JASCOM MEETING**  
**March 3, 2016, 5:30 p.m.**  
**City of Lacey Executive Boardroom**

- MEETING BEGAN:** The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chair Jeff Gadman.
- APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Member Nicole Hill moved that the agenda be accepted as presented; member Jessica Bateman seconded the motion and the agenda was accepted unanimously.
- PUBLIC COMMENT:** none
- APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Member Nicole Hill moved to approve the February 4, 2016 minutes; member Jessica Bateman seconded the motion. Motion passed and the minutes were approved unanimously.
- CORRESPONDENCE:** none
- ACTION ITEMS:** none
- DISCUSSION ITEMS:** Private source funding reserves: Executive Director Ric Torgerson distributed a spreadsheet detailing the balances in Animal Services' private funding accounts. He noted there are only two foundations represented, so he will be identifying and recruiting potential funding organizations. The remaining accounts are attributable largely to estates and individual on-going donations. Donated revenue to date is \$2,201,036, with a current balance of \$1,243,380. Many of the funds are restricted.
- Member Sandra Romero asked that members be given a copy of the capital facilities plan to determine how they should be funded.
- Member Doug Howie expressed concern that significant donations from Thurston County Humane Society were not on the spreadsheet—Ric explained that only accounts currently showing a balance were on this document. Funds from TCHS were fully expended on the projects for which they were granted.
- Members would like to see the spreadsheet modified, specifically: totals by type of restricted use and unrestricted funds, when each account originated, any interest earned, definitions of acronyms as well as clearer explanations of restrictions, and to fix the page breaks.
- STAFF PRESENTATION:** Chandra Mincher, Education and Volunteer Coordinator, explained the current state of the volunteer program, education programs and other outreach projects. Notably, last year 245 volunteers donated 6,746 hours, equating more than 3.25 FTE. 74 foster homes cared for 86 individual pets and litters. Chandra is developing a mentoring system to better support new and current volunteers.
- Education and outreach programs include printed and online information, shelter presentations addressing dog and cat body language, safety around animals, pet care and animal shelter operations, each tailored to various age groups. Chandra and volunteers

also attend many community events, offering interactive activities and information. Chair Jeff Gadman suggested the body language information be posted on our website.

**DIRECTOR'S REPORT:** Executive Director Ric Torgerson briefed the members regarding:

Sharon Gold, Furever Rescue, which has culminated in a multi-agency investigation. There are concerns about licensing, permitting, health certificates for out-of-country animals being brought in, and other issues. Animal Services is peripherally involved at this time, as no specific animal welfare violations have been substantiated.

Suzanne Tatham, who had been harassing staff regarding a situation over which Animal Services had no jurisdiction. This has resulted in a no-trespass order, a restraining order, as well as seizure of her two dogs and her horses due to abandonment after her arrest.

Thurston County Connection on TCTV with Sandra Romero, Ric and Field Officer Erika Johnson. Members asked to be notified when it is scheduled to air.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** Executive Director Ric Torgerson introduced the newly hired Shelter Manager, Heather Leu.

**SHELTER STATISTICS:** Deanna Johnson noted that there were no significant issues.
